The White Handflare is designed for use in the day and at night in short-range collision situations as a collision warning signal, or it can be used for illuminating small areas where an intense white light is required. It features a unique telescopic handle, which makes the signal compact and saves space in stowage. Easily extended for safe handling and operation by pull wire ignitor. Produces hot white flame for 60 seconds at 2,500 candela.
