OPERATIONAL USE

- The user removes the TPA from the bag unfolds it and then climbs into it ensuring that the product is fully on.
- The wearer gathers the spare excess fabric at the front and pulls the zip up towards the chin ensuring that the excess fabric is safely pulled towards the body.
