OVER 100 YEARS OF BEING BUOYANT IN SURVIVAL



Our heritage of Survival Technology began in 1920 with a chance encounter between airship balloon expert Reginald Foster Dagnall and an old friend.

The friend needed flotation solutions to save aircraft ditched at sea, and Dagnall needed a new challenge – so the deal was done. Dagnall founded RFD, the original Survitec company, in a garden shed in Surrey, England.





HOW OUR HERITAGE SHAPED OUR PURPOSE

Our technology quickly evolved to protect lives, rather than aircraft.

For Reginald, protecting lives was more important than salvaging aircraft, a vision the world would quickly agree with.

Reginald experimented with inflatable technology and perfected a mechanism for reliable, automatic inflation in water - this quickly evolved into the world's first inflatable liferaft.

RFD, now Survitec, continues to build on the strong foundations Reginald had built, innovating market leading Survival Technology solutions to protect lives.
